

How a motorcycle emissions self-testing facility might look like

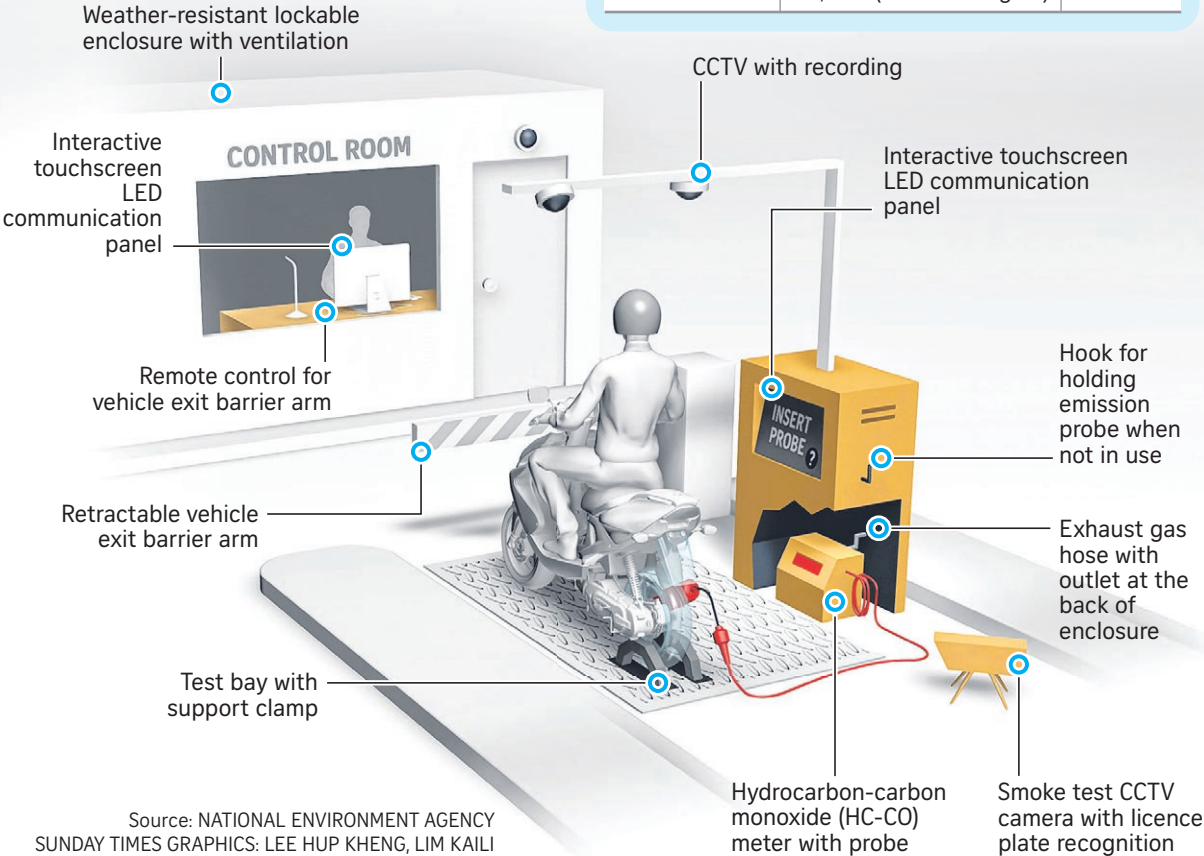
The National Environment Agency put up a tender on Aug 25 for a facility that will allow emissions tests to be done under the remote supervision of NEA officers stationed at a nearby control room.

IDLE TEST LIMITS



All motorcycles entering the checkpoint must comply with the following emissions requirements with effect from April 6, 2023.

Carbon monoxide (vol %)	Hydrocarbon (ppm)	Smoke
≤ 4.5	≤ 7,800 (2-stroke engine) ≤ 2,000 (4-stroke engine)	No visible smoke
