

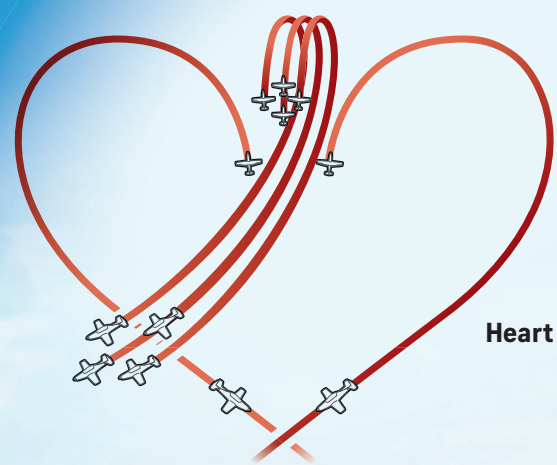
Largest number of flying teams at Singapore Airshow 2024

The Singapore Airshow 2024 will feature aerial manoeuvres performed by six countries' air forces – including the Republic of Singapore Air Force – and two commercial firms, making it the largest line-up of foreign flying teams in the biennial aerospace event to date. During Weekend@Airshow on Feb 24 and 25, when the public can attend the event at Changi Exhibition Centre, visitors can expect to be dazzled by the flying teams' slick moves with fancy names, such as "snake loop" and "dolphin's leap".

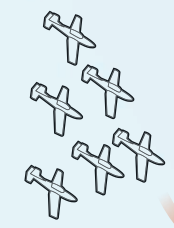

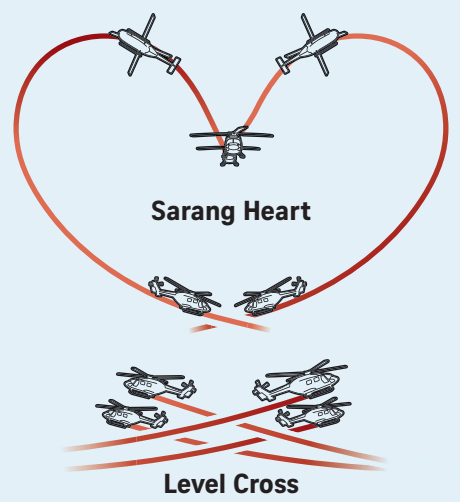
