DID YOU KNOW?


Did you know there's a type of Chinese folk art where blacksmiths cast hammered molten iron against a surface like a wall, creating a shower of sparks that looks like fireworks? This artform is called "iron flower" and is popular in areas such as Henan and Shanxi in China.

CELEBRATE PONGAL

Pongal is a Hindu harvest festival celebrated by the Tamil community. It is dedicated to thanking the Hindu sun deity Surya, nature and farm animals. It marks the start of the Tamil month of Thai and was celebrated from Jan 14 to 17 in 2026.


Traditionally, a dish also called pongal is made during the festival. The mixture of sweet rice is typically cooked in a claypot until it boils over, to symbolise abundance. The dish is offered to Surya and served to family members and visitors.

Pongal pots are frequently painted with designs like flowers, leaves or mandalas, then decorated with turmeric leaves or flower garlands. How would you decorate your pot?
