

HERITAGE SITES AROUND THE REGION



Malacca and George Town, historic cities of The Strait of Malacca (Malaysia)

The two historic colonial towns are famous for their multicultural heritage which have created a unique architecture, culture and townscape.



Angkor (Cambodia)

The remains of the Khmer Empire that harks back to the 9th to 15th century. The park is inhabited and the people are mostly farmers.



The Great Wall (China)

Built over a continuous period from the 3rd century BC to the 17th century AD, it is the world's largest military structure.



Rice Terraces of the Philippine Cordilleras (Philippines)

Built by the Ifugao ethnic group 2,000 years ago. The rice terraces, distributed across five sites, follow the contours of the mountains.
