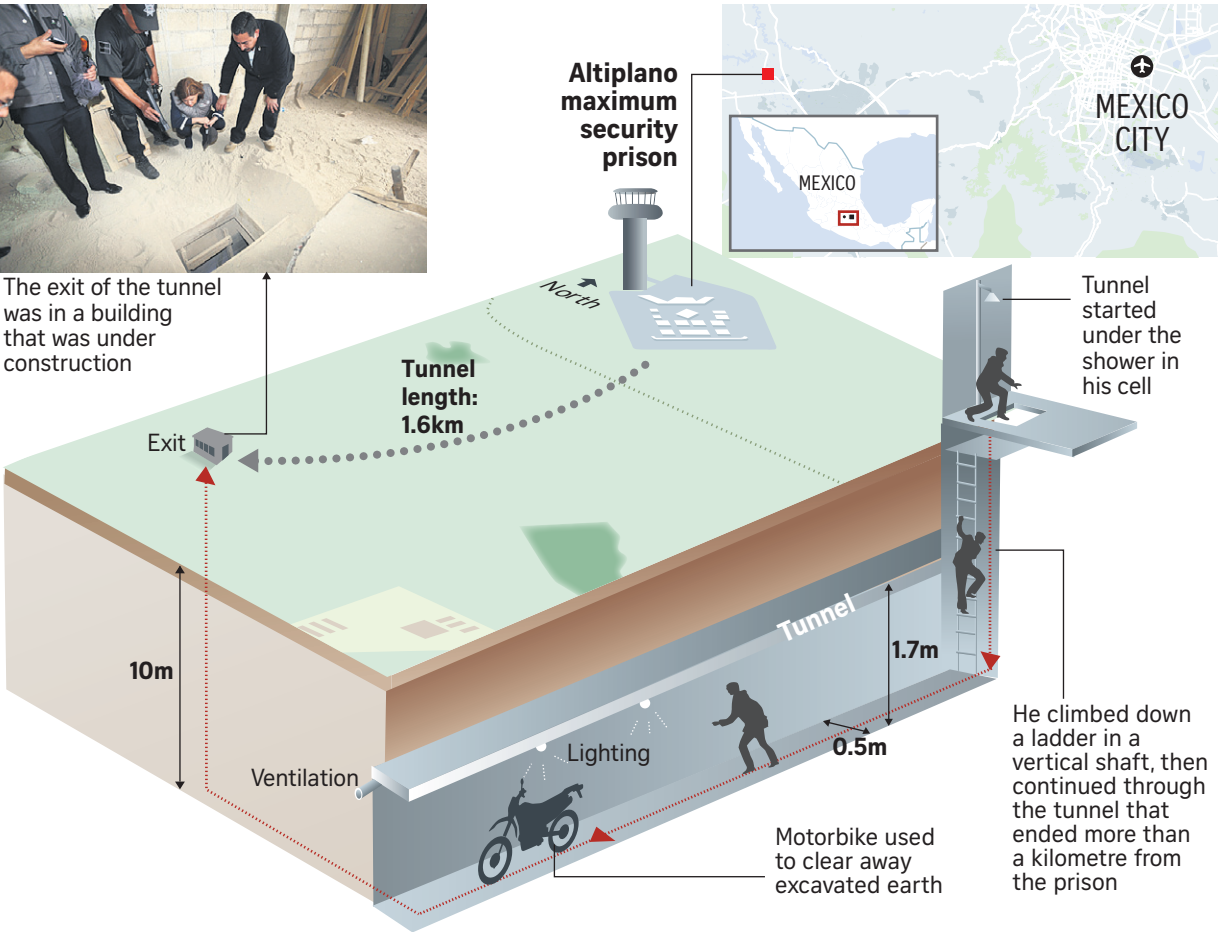


Prison break

Other great escapes

- On April 25, 2011, more than 480 Taliban insurgents and other inmates of the Sarposha prison in Kandahar City dug a 320m tunnel to freedom.
- Pascal Payet broke out of a French prison twice using a helicopter in 2001 and 2003.
- Thirty-eight Irish Republican Army prisoners busted out of the Maze, located 16km west of Belfast, in 1983 with the help of guns smuggled into the prison.
- In 1975, Billy Hayes, a 23-year-old American student imprisoned on Imrali Island in the Bosphorous Strait, escaped in a rowboat before making his way to Greece and being deported to America.
- Hardened criminals Frank Morris, John and Clarence Anglin dug their way out of what was supposed to be America's only escape-proof prison, Alcatraz, on June 11, 1962.
