


Forty minutes of terror




1. Ayoub El Khazzani removes his shirt in the train toilet and grabs his assault rifle. Strapped to his chest is a bag filled with 270 rounds of ammunition. At 5.35pm, he opens the toilet door.




2. A French banker waiting his turn for the toilet grabs him and they struggle for 15 seconds.



3. Another passenger rushes to help but is knocked to the ground. Khazzani aims his rifle at the French banker and shoots. Glass breaks, causing panic in cars 11 and 12.



4. In car 12, two Americans – Mr Spencer Stone and Mr Alek Skarlatos – see Khazzani. Mr Stone tackles Khazzani to the ground while Mr Skarlatos grabs the rifle and beats Khazzani in the head with it. The attacker tries to use his pistol but no bullet comes out. He gets trapped in a headlock but fights Mr Stone with a box cutter, slicing the American in his neck and thumb.



5. Mr Skarlatos and other passengers help Mr Stone. At least one more shot is fired, injuring a French-American man. Khazzani loses consciousness and is tied up. Several panicked passengers break windows and jump out. When the train arrives in the city of Arras, Khazzani is arrested.
