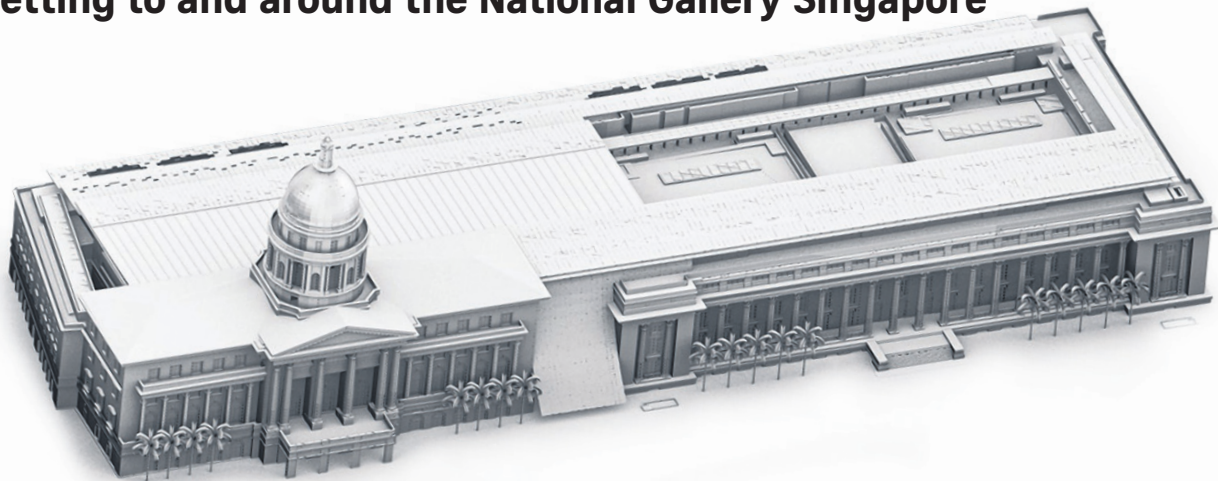


Getting to and around the National Gallery Singapore



Fast facts

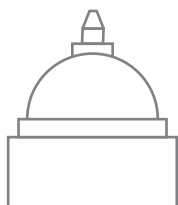
• Gazetted as national monuments, the City Hall and former Supreme Court buildings were focal points for many important events in Singapore's history. It was in the City Hall building that Admiral Lord Louis Mountbatten accepted the surrender of the Japanese forces on Sept 12, 1945, on behalf of the Allied forces.

• City Hall, which was built between 1926 and 1929, has housed various government departments. It was vacated in 2005.

• The adjacent Supreme Court building was built between 1930 and 1939. Its facade was designed to match City Hall with classical architecture and corresponding Corinthian columns.

• The two colonial buildings were refurbished at a cost of \$532 million to create the 64,000 sq m National Gallery Singapore.

2008: studioMilou Architecture was selected as the designer for the Gallery.

A permanent sheltered 290m walkway links City Hall MRT to the Gallery's Coleman Street entrance.

• Buses

Coleman Street entrance
130 stops at the Gallery's Coleman Street entrance.

63, 51, 80, 32 and 851
stop opposite Peninsula Plaza.

Padang Atrium entrance
195 stops at the Gallery's Parliament Place entrance.

• Parking

Entrance is on Coleman Street. The Gallery's carpark is on the far right of Coleman Street right after you turn in from St Andrew's Road.

• Taxi stand

At the Gallery's Coleman Street entrance.
