

Crash, spill, gridlock

Southbound vehicles on the Bukit Timah Expressway were stuck in a gridlock that stretched from Woodlands Avenue 3 to the Kranji Expressway.

What happened

- At 3am, a car was believed to have crashed into the rear of a Malaysian registered tanker carrying palm oil, causing it to leak its cargo onto the road.
- The spillage left two lanes completely slick with oil and lard and forced traffic to a standstill during the morning peak hour.
