

- The road-rail vehicles (RRVs) and sleepers are lifted onto the tracks using a cradle at a speed of about 2.5m per minute. They can be moved from the ground and onto the tracks in less than 15 minutes.

- The crane can lift 40 tonnes, the equivalent of two RRVs or more than 100 concrete sleepers.
- For safety reasons the crane carries only one RRV or 52 sleepers at one time.



- 20m high, 22m wide, 74 tonnes
- Made of structural steel
