

# Crime trends



## Law and order situation "favourable"

Slight increase in crime rate fuelled by spike in online crime. But almost all other types of crime register decreases. Rates of re-offending remain low.



## Drugs

The drug situation is stable but the number of new young drug abusers, especially those under 30 years old, continues to rise.



## Immigration

Increase in the number of arrests for harbouring and employing immigration offenders.



## The Home Team's increased workload

Officers will have to deal with increased demand for emergency ambulance services, and increased traffic at checkpoints.



## Terror threat

Terrorism is the country's most significant threat. The public can play a major role by alerting the authorities to potential dangers and warning signs, such as self-radicalised individuals.



## Fires

Number of fires down. Fire fatalities have remained low in the past decade, at under 0.1 deaths per 100,000 people on average.



## Roads and traffic

Overall road safety situation is positive, with a decrease in road fatalities.



## Community initiatives

The Home Team will increase its network of community volunteers, who can respond to life-saving emergencies before its officers arrive.
