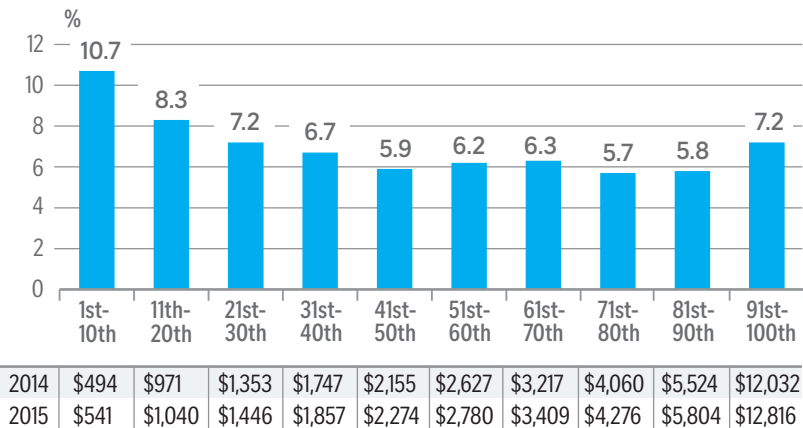


Incomes up for every family

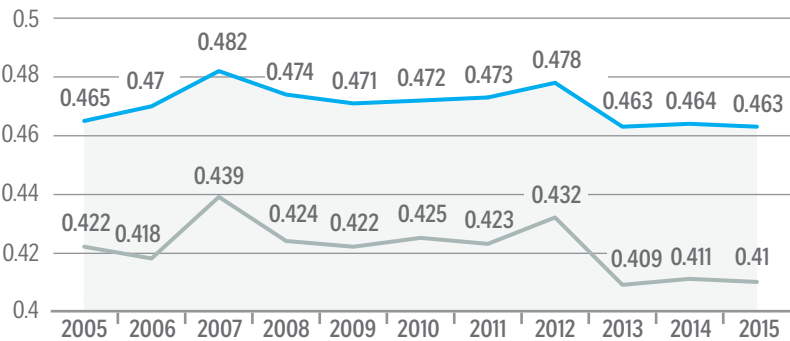
Households at the bottom enjoyed the biggest increases in real income growth.

Income gap remains stable

The 2015 Gini coefficient – a measure of income inequality – was one of the lowest in recent years. Government transfers and taxes reduced the coefficient from 0.463 to 0.41 last year.



Gini coefficient of employed households
