

Keeping tabs on flights



- From July 1, Singapore Airlines, SilkAir, Scoot, Tigerair, Jetstar Asia and SIA Cargo must ensure all flights are tracked at least every 15 minutes.
- This requirement is two years ahead of an expected global ruling.
- Mandatory flight tracking aims to avoid a repeat of the MH370 tragedy, in which a Malaysia Airlines jet vanished in March 2014 and has yet to be found.
