

OBS @ Coney: Possible activities



Sailing, rowboating and kayaking on coastal waters between Ubin, Changi and Tekong, offering more challenging sea expeditions and technical challenges.



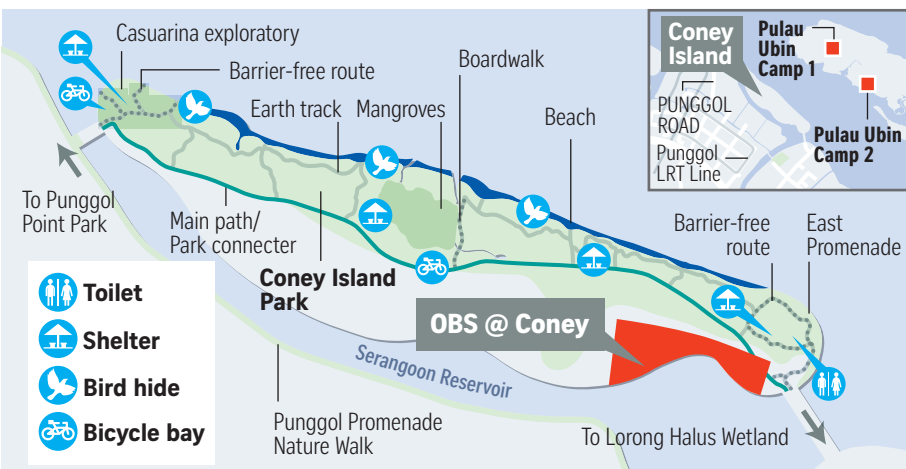
Outrigger canoeing and rafting at sheltered waters between Ubin and Sembawang. Participants can build their own rafts, and live aboard for a unique camping experience.



Cycling and coastal paddling in which participants ride along Pasir Ris Park, Changi Beach and East Coast Beach on customised bicycles with wheelchairs or kayaks in tow, to explore coastal waterways and park connectors.



Cycling and urban trekking in which participants can explore the Central Catchment area on foot and bicycles, and pick up bag-packing and bicycle touring skills.



New challenge rope courses at the Coney campus can accommodate a lot more participants at one go, compared with current rope courses on the Pulau Ubin campus.



Mountaineering concepts may be introduced, and tasks may require participants to build rope bridges across bodies of water.



As much as possible, the campsites at the Coney campus will not be built-up, allowing participants to erect their own tents on camping sites.



Artificial caves and tunnels may be built at the Coney campus for teams to experience being in a dark environment together, which will teach them problem-solving skills.
