TRADE AND ECONOMICS

• Easing trade rules in the Singapore-Australia Free Trade Agreement to reduce red tape and increase trade

- More access for businesses to bid for both governments' procurement contracts
- Start negotiations for mutual recognition of professional qualifications, with priority given to engineers and accountants

• More opportunities for Singapore investors in Australia with higher acquisition thresholds



INNOVATION AND SCIENCE

• Companies can tap a \$50 million matching fund over five years

• Singapore chosen as an innovation "landing pad" to support high-tech Australian start-ups and link them up with networks, to drive business development. Singapore is one of five cities chosen



DEFENCE

• Spend up to A\$2.25 billion (S\$2.25 billion) and expand military training areas for Singapore troops to access over a period of 25 years; Australian troops will also get to use the training grounds

- Elevate joint combat training drill, code-named Trident, to a signature bilateral exercise
- Share more intelligence and information in areas such as counter-terrorism

• Hold an inaugural security forum in Australia later this year to discuss regional security issues



EDUCATION

 Recognise Juris Doctor degrees from approved Australian and Singapore universities

• Recognise more post-graduate medical degrees from two universities and 15 allied health qualifications in occupational therapy, physiotherapy and speech therapy



YOUTH

• Up to 500 young people from each side can cross over to work and study for up to 12 months to enhance their holiday and cultural experience

• Give 100 Singaporeans studying in Australia more internship opportunities with leading Australian companies
