

SQ368 fire: Timeline of events

All passengers and crew were safe after the plane made an emergency landing back at Changi Airport yesterday.

2.05am yesterday

Flight SQ368 with 222 passengers and 19 crew on board leaves Changi Airport Terminal 3 for Milan, Italy.

About an hour and 45 minutes into the flight

Pilots receive an engine oil warning message and turn the aircraft around.

6.49am

Aircraft lands, then the right engine catches fire.

6.51am

Firefighters arrive.

6.54am

Fire is brought under control.

7.10am

Passengers disembark using stairs and are transported to the terminal building by bus.

8.18am

Aircraft is towed to remote parking bay.

8.20am

Cleanup and repair of runway begins.

10.59am

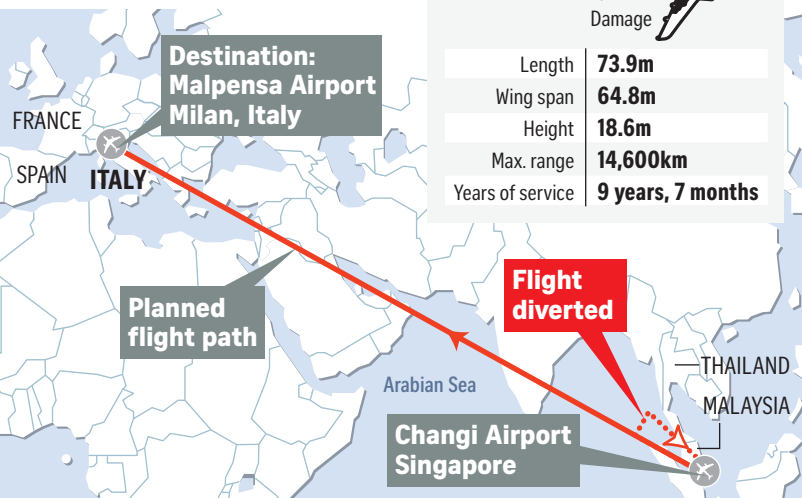
Replacement flight (SQ368D) departs.

11.30am

Runway 2 reopens following inspection.
