The sculpture is intended to invite people to slow down their footsteps and listen to nature's whispers in the park.

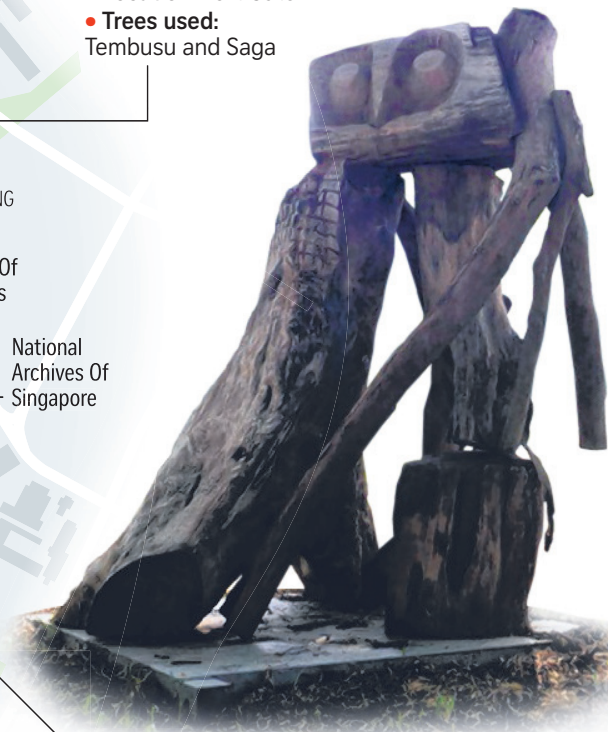
- Artist: Lim Soo Ngee
