

SMRT: Facts and figures



RAIL

- Operates and maintains the North-South and East-West lines and the Circle Line with a total route length of 129.8km across 84 stations.
- Operates and maintains the Bukit Panjang Light Rail Transit system, comprising 7.8km of elevated guideways across 14 stations.
- Average daily ridership of about two million passenger trips.

Revenue **\$681 million**

Operating profit **\$7.4 million**



BUSES

- Manages a fleet of over 1,400 buses, providing 106 bus services connecting the western and north-western areas with the rest of Singapore.
- Average daily ridership of about one million passenger trips

Revenue **\$248.5 million**

Operating profit **\$5.9 million**



TAXIS

- Third largest taxi operator in Singapore
- Manages a fleet of more than 3,500 taxis

Revenue **\$147.9 million**

Operating profit **\$17 million**
