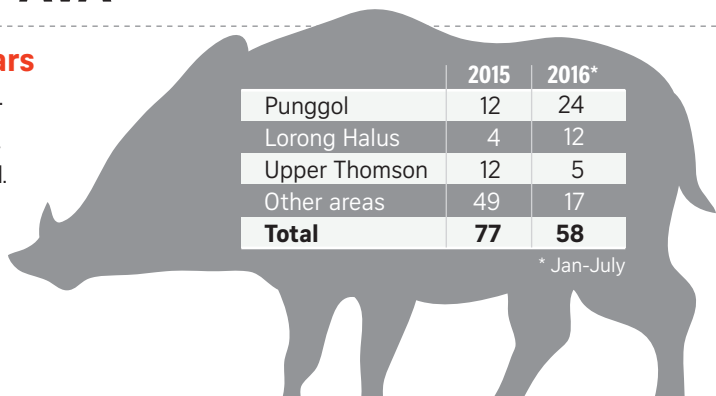


Sightings reported to AVA

What to do when you meet wild boars

- Be calm and move away slowly from the animals.
- Do not approach or attempt to feed the boars. Feeding wild boars alters their behaviour and may cause them to become reliant on humans for food.
- Keep a safe distance from them and do not corner or provoke the animals, such as by using a flash while taking pictures of them.
- If you see adult boars with young piglets, leave them alone. These are potentially more dangerous because they may attempt to defend their young.
