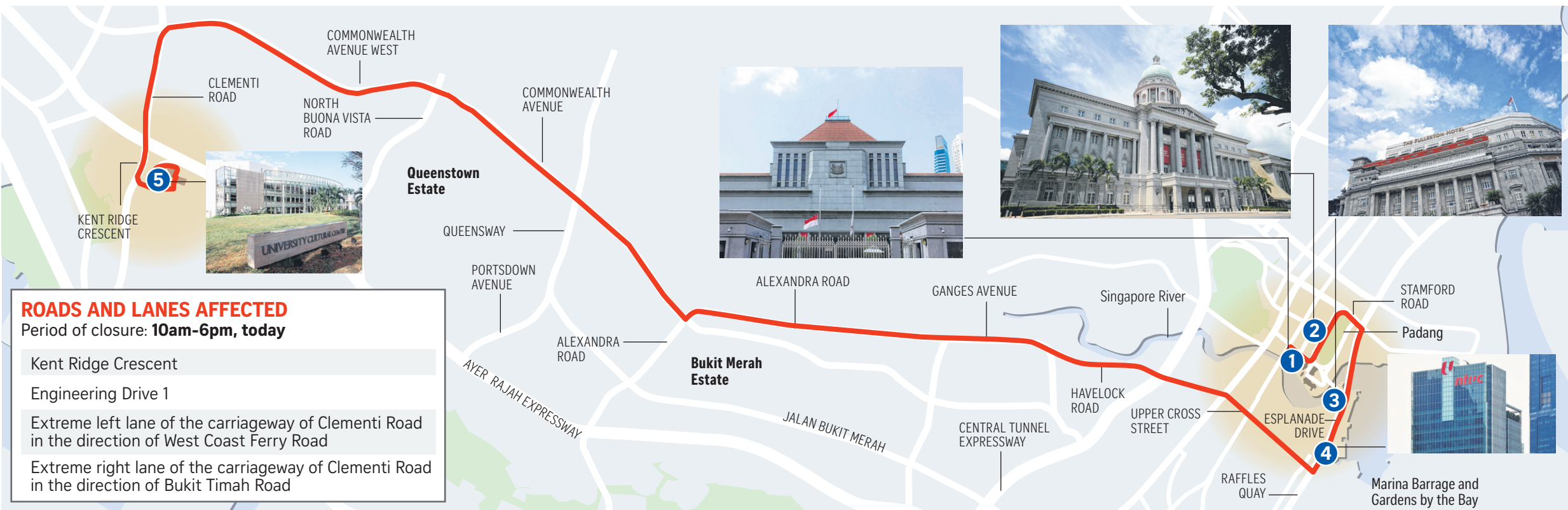


# State funeral procession

## 1 Parliament House

The procession will pass by landmarks of significance to the late Mr Nathan.

## 2 City Hall

Mr Nathan, Singapore's longest-serving President, reviewed the National Day Parade here in 2000, 2005 and 2010.

## 3 Fullerton Hotel

Early in his public service career, Mr Nathan was appointed as a Seamen's Welfare Officer at the Marine Department, located at the Fullerton Building, now the Fullerton Hotel.

## 4 NTUC Centre

Between 1962 and 1965, Mr Nathan served in the Labour Research Unit, a unit of the National Trades Union Congress (NTUC). He helped NTUC overcome the challenge posed by pro-communist unions.

## 5 University Cultural Centre

A state funeral service for Mr Nathan will be held at 3pm at the centre.

## State funeral service

Seven eulogies will be delivered during the funeral service at UCC, in this order:

- Ambassador-at-large Tommy Koh
- Former Senior Minister of State for Foreign Affairs Zainul Abidin Rasheed
- Ambassador to Mexico Jennie Chua,

former chairman of Community Chest

- Fairfax Asia chairman and chief executive Ramaswamy Athappan
- Labour chief Chan Chun Sing
- Ambassador-at-large Gopinath Pillai

After the service, the casket will be carried out of the UCC hall and the procession will leave for a private funeral service at Mandai Crematorium.
