

The safeguards include:



A person must be at least 21 years old to open a player account.

Operators have to

verify the identity

and age of the

player in person

before accounts

can be activated.



Alerting the player when he exceeds 75 per cent of his expenditure limit.



Advertisements and promotional activities to encourage people to engage in remote gambling are forbidden.



Displaying a time counter to indicate how long a player has been logged on.



Players must set daily spending and funding limits. Any increase in expenditure limits will take effect only on the next day, while cuts will kick in immediately.



The National Council on Problem Gambling will conduct checks to ensure players are not on casino exclusion orders.



Operators must implement a self-exclusion system and display responsible gambling messages.
