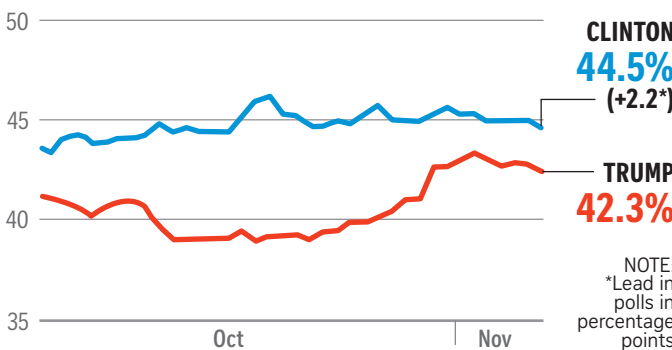
Chance of winning

(The New York Times derives the probability from the voting history of each state, as well as state and national polls conducted since mid-April. Figures as of yesterday.)



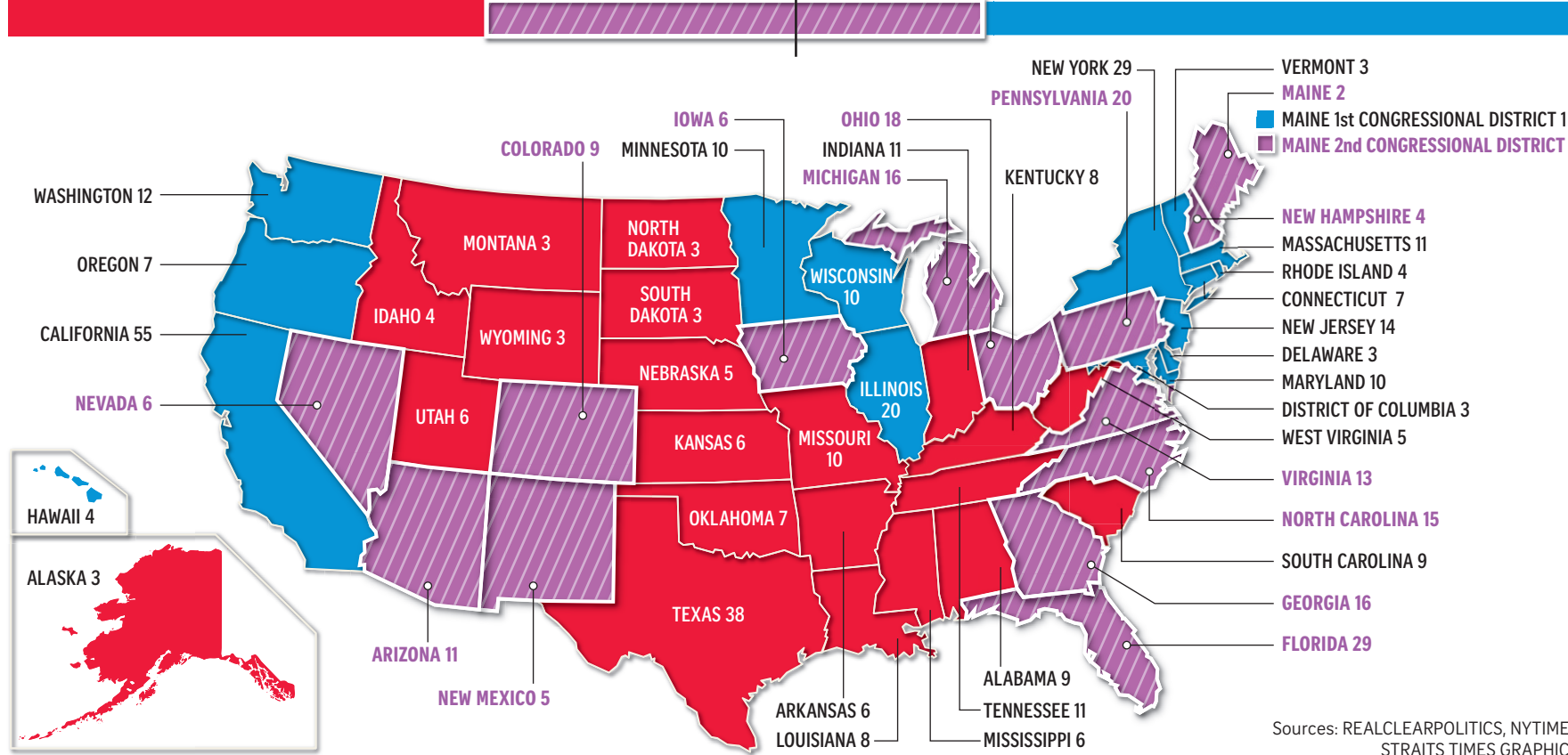
National opinion polls

(Based on RealClearPolitics data, which tracks average support received by a candidate across several national polls in a four-way race between Democrat Hillary Clinton, Republican Donald Trump, Libertarian nominee Gary Johnson and the Green Party's Jill Stein. Figures as of yesterday.)



Predicted electoral college votes

(Each state is allocated a certain number out of a total of 538 electoral college votes and a candidate needs to win at least 270 votes to get into the Oval Office.)
