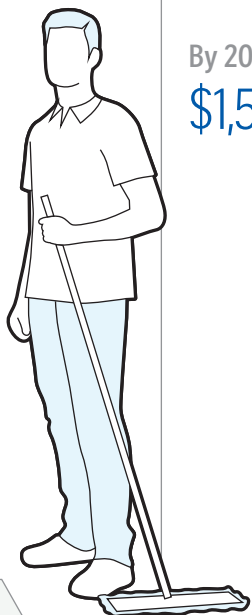

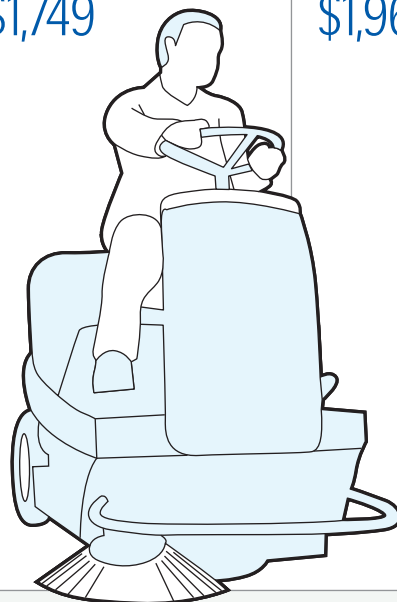

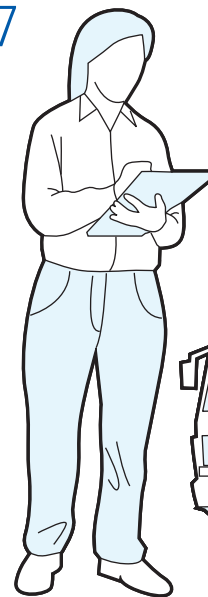

### Changes

**+\$60** rise in basic wage level from July 2017, and again from July 2018

**+\$80** rise in basic wage levels from July 2019

**+3%** annual rise in basic wage levels for 2020, 2021 and 2022 plus annual bonus of two weeks every year
