NOTE: Culpability refers to the level of the offender's blameworthiness. Factors to assess culpability include the number of breaches; whether the breaches were systemic or isolated; whether the breaches were intentional, rash or negligent; whether the breaches were a minor departure from established procedures or a complete disregard of procedures

Potential harm refers to the harm that could potentially have resulted from the offender's actions. It may be assessed by considering, among other things, the seriousness of the possible harm and the likelihood of that harm arising.
