

Swift and deadly

CCTV footage revealed startling details of how two female agents carried out Monday's killing of Mr Kim Jong Nam at Kuala Lumpur International Airport 2 (KLIA2).



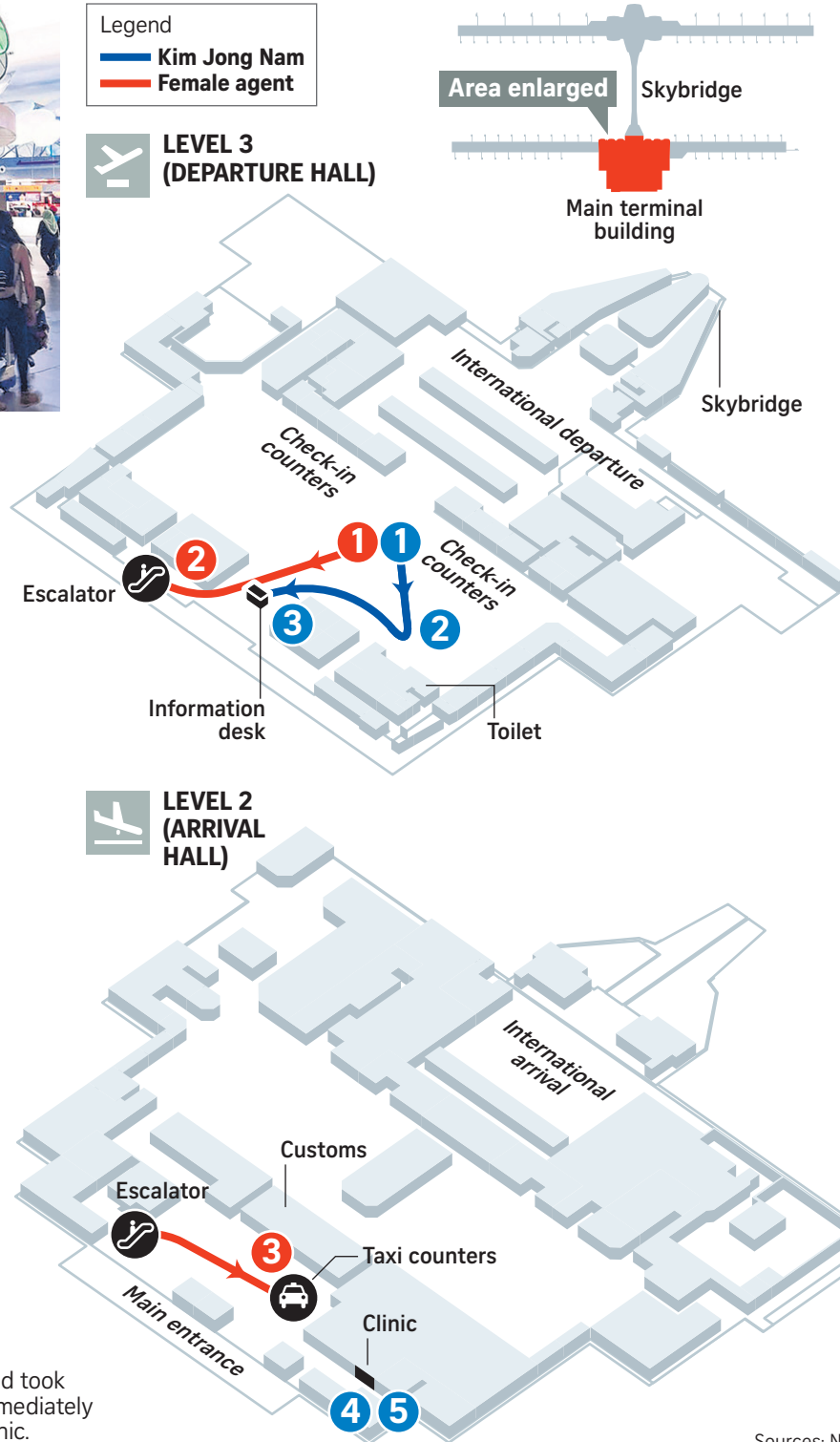
1 Mr Kim, standing among a small crowd in front of the self-check-in counter (above), was attacked here at around 8.20am on Monday.

- One of the assailants stood in front of him to distract him while the other (right) came up from behind to put a liquid-laced cloth over his face.
- It is believed that Mr Kim was waiting for his 10.50am flight back to Macau.



- 2** He headed to the toilet but turned back to seek help at the information desk.
- 3** An airport staff member attended to him and took him to the clinic one floor below. It is not immediately clear which route they used to get to the clinic.

- 4** Mr Kim received medical attention at the clinic, where he had a mild seizure.
- 5** As his condition worsened, he was taken to Putrajaya Hospital. He died on the way there.



- 2** One of the assailants made her way briskly to the taxi stand one floor below.
- 3** She bought a taxi coupon and fled in a taxi. The woman, a 28-year-old who holds a Vietnamese passport, was tracked down and arrested at KLIA2 at 8.20am on Wednesday.

Malaysian police yesterday confirmed that a second woman, a 25-year-old who holds an Indonesian passport, has been detained in connection with the case.
