

FIGHTING KEY THREATS

The ministries of Defence and Home Affairs yesterday outlined key strategies to prepare for threats such as cyber attacks and terrorism



STRONG CYBER DEFENCE

- New Defence Cyber Organisation and Cyber Defence Group to tackle cyber security threats
- Cyber security vocation for national servicemen



BETTER TRAINING

- New 88ha Safti City in western Singapore to let soldiers hone urban fighting skills
- New Instrumented Battle Circuits in training areas of Pasir Laba, Ama Keng and Murai Urban Training Facility

SMART DEFENCE

- Two new defence technology labs, to develop robotics, and tap artificial intelligence and data analytics



DEEPER COUNTER-TERRORISM CAPABILITIES

- Registering iris images for checkpoints and equipping frontline policemen with pistols
- Changes to the law to protect public events and infrastructure
- SGSecure outreach to be expanded to workplaces
