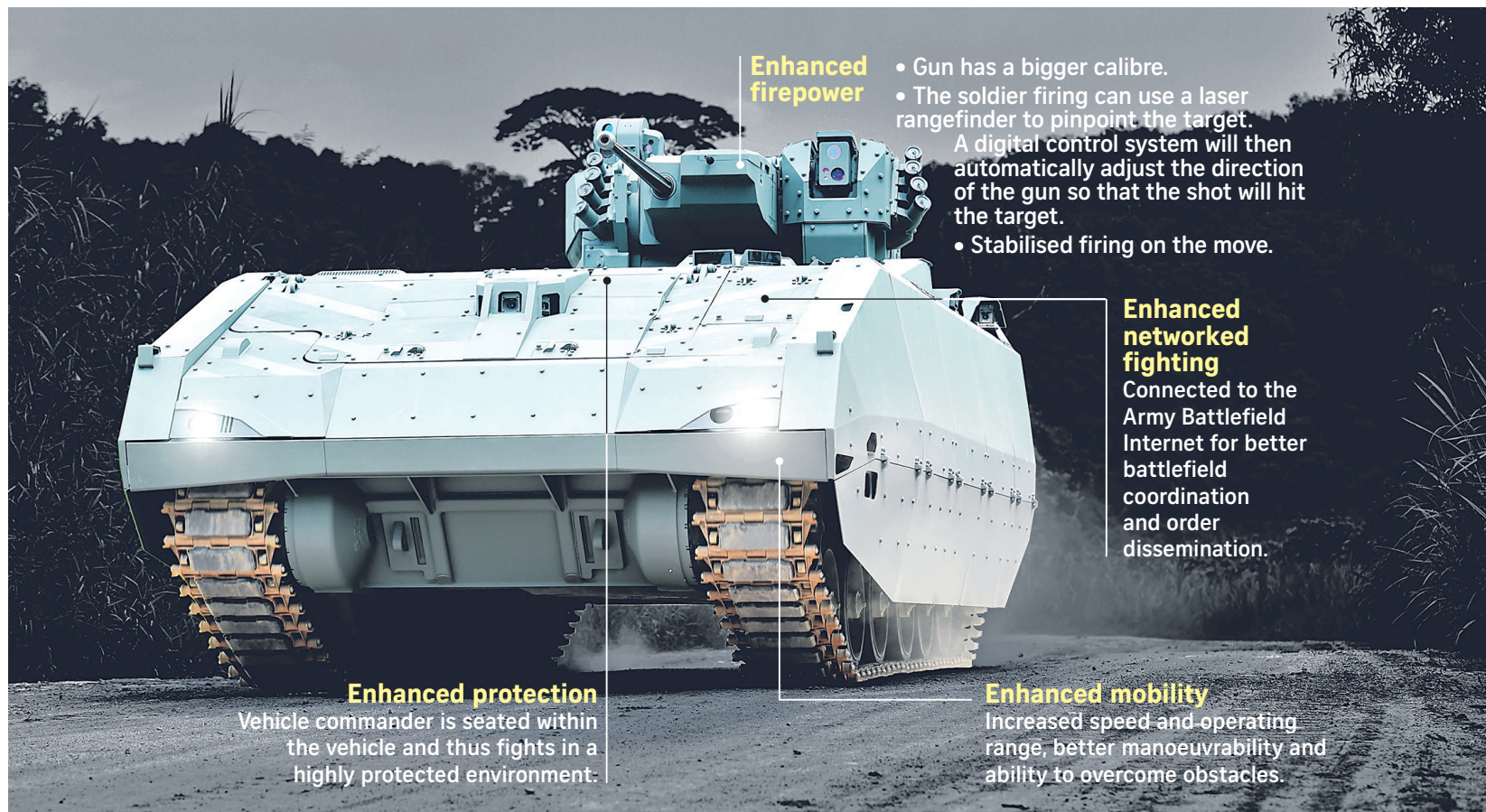


ST Engineering to produce SAF's next-generation armoured fighting vehicle

The new AFV will replace the Ultra M113 AFV which has been in service since the early 1970s



Enhanced firepower

- Gun has a bigger calibre.
- The soldier firing can use a laser rangefinder to pinpoint the target. A digital control system will then automatically adjust the direction of the gun so that the shot will hit the target.
- Stabilised firing on the move.

Enhanced networked fighting

Connected to the Army Battlefield Internet for better battlefield coordination and order dissemination.

Enhanced protection

Vehicle commander is seated within the vehicle and thus fights in a highly protected environment.

Enhanced mobility

Increased speed and operating range, better manoeuvrability and ability to overcome obstacles.
