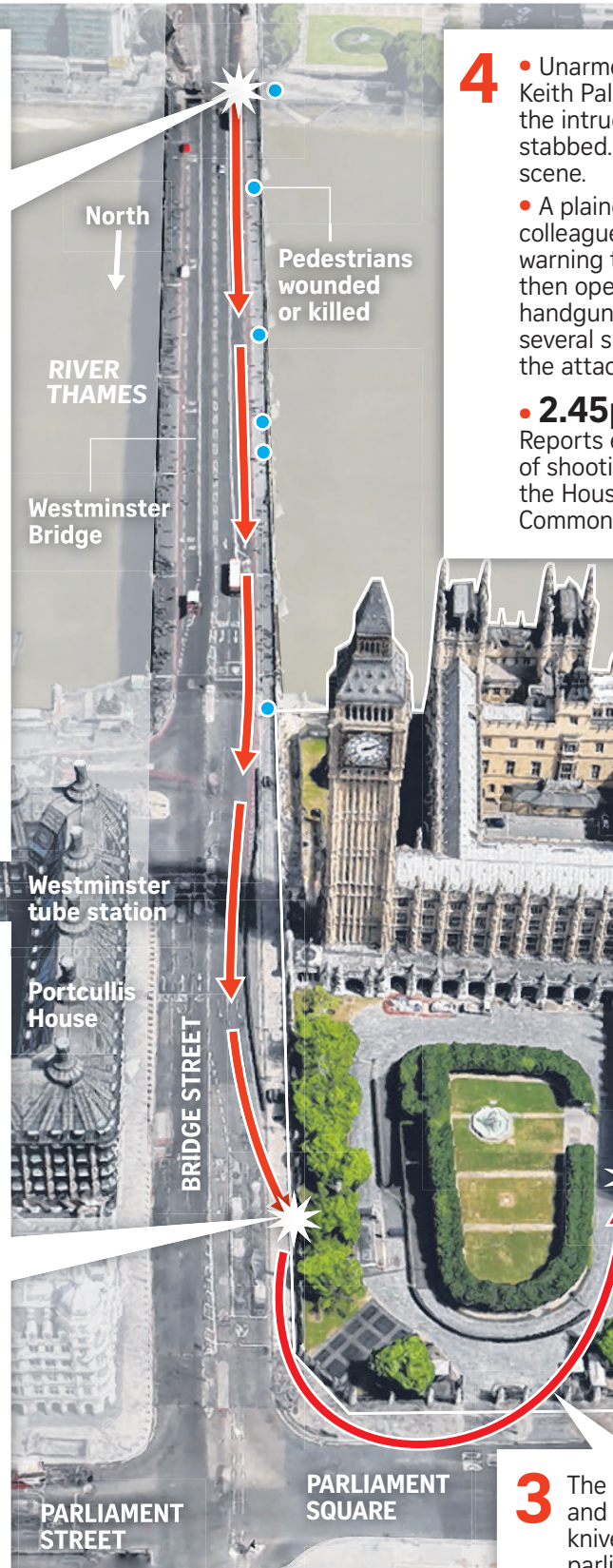


The scene: How the tragedy unfolded

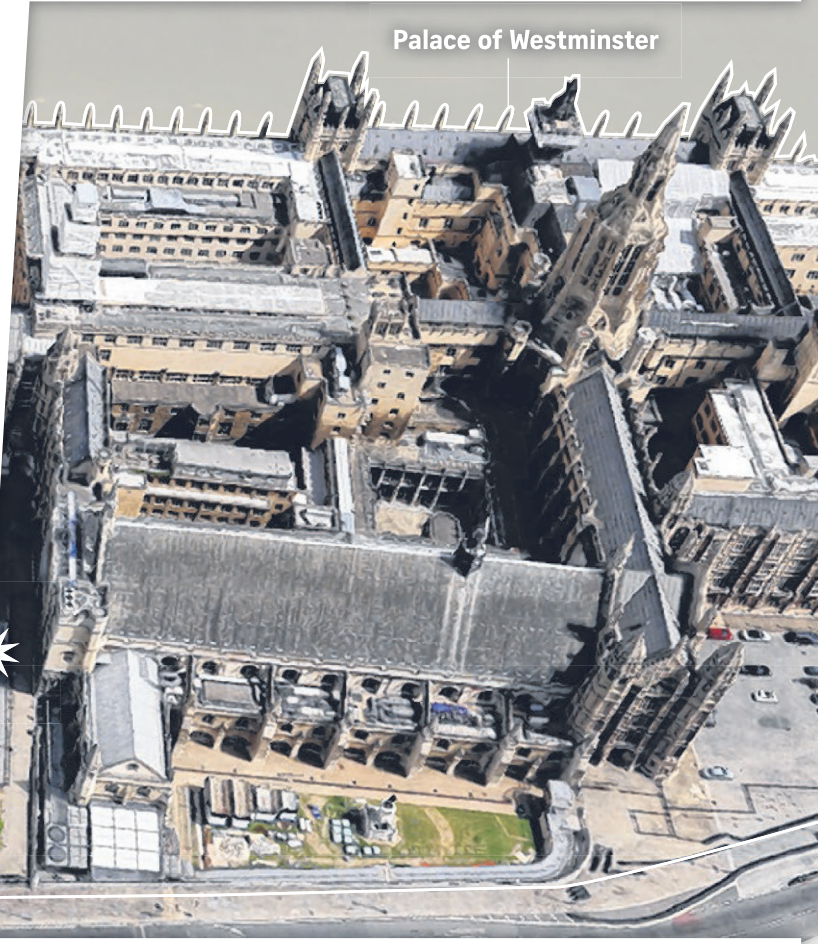
- 1 2.40pm:** Police are called to Westminster Bridge after a Hyundai 4x4 mounts the pavement on the south end of Westminster Bridge, hitting and injuring a man.
- It mows down pedestrians as it speeds north at 80kmh towards the Palace of Westminster.
 - Two people die on the bridge. Dozens more are injured, including three French schoolboys and three policemen.
 - A woman jumps or falls into the river. She is later rescued, alive.
 - The car hits a pedestrian on the north end of the bridge.



- 2** After crossing the bridge, the attacker crashes the car into railings by Big Ben, across the road from Westminster tube station and Portcullis House.



- 4** • Unarmed policeman Keith Palmer tries to stop the intruder and is stabbed. He dies at the scene.
- A plainclothes colleague shouts a warning to the attacker then opens fire with a handgun. He fires several shots, killing the attacker.
- 2.45pm:** Reports emerge of shooting at the House of Commons.



- 3** The crowds scatter and shout as the attacker jumps from the wreckage and runs around the corner into Parliament Square. He carries two large knives and charges through security in Old Palace Yard, into the parliamentary compound.
