Today, the six City Harvest Church leaders convicted of misappropriating millions in church funds will find out if their appeals have succeeded, or if they have to face the longer jail sentences which the prosecution is asking for.



Tan Ye Peng, 44, deputy senior pastor

Convicted of: Six charges of criminal breach of trust and four charges of falsification of accounts

Sentence: Five-and-a-half years

What prosecution is asking for: 11 to 12 years

Chew Eng Han, 56, former CHC fund manager

Convicted of: Six charges of criminal breach of trust and four charges of falsification of accounts

Sentence: Six years

What prosecution is asking for: 11 to 12 years

John Lam, 49, former CHC finance committee member

Convicted of: Three charges of criminal breach of trust

Sentence: Three years

What prosecution is asking for: Eight to nine years

Kong Hee, 52, CHC founder and senior pastor

Convicted of: Three charges of criminal breach of trust

Sentence: Eight years

What prosecution is asking for: 11 to 12 years

Sharon Tan, 41, former CHC finance manager who took over from Serina Wee

Convicted of: Three charges of criminal breach of trust and four charges of falsification of accounts

Sentence: 21 months

What prosecution is asking for: Five to six years

Serina Wee, 40, former CHC finance manager

Convicted of: Six charges of criminal breach of trust and four charges of falsification of accounts

Sentence: Five years

What prosecution is asking for: 11 to 12 years
