BRITAIN

Some 40 organisations under Britain's National Health Service were hit by the virus on Friday, causing medical operations and appointments across the country to be cancelled as doctors were unable to retrieve patients' files.

SPAIN

Telecoms giant Telefonica was among the first to be infected worldwide. Other companies like power firm Iberdrola and utility provider Gas Natural took pre-emptive steps, asking staff to turn off their computers.

RUSSIA

Russia has reportedly seen more infections than any other country. Some 1,000 computers at the Russian Interior Ministry were affected, as were Sberbank, the country's largest bank, the Health Ministry and the state railway.
