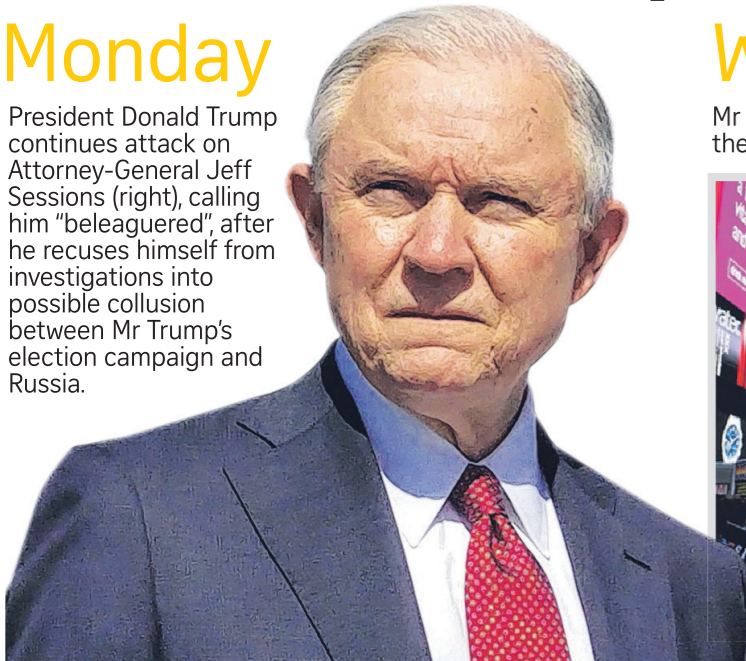


# A week of Trump drama

## Wednesday

## Thursday

New White House communications director Anthony Scaramucci's (left) expletive-laden attack on chief of staff Reince Priebus and chief strategist Steve Bannon (right) hits the news.



## Friday

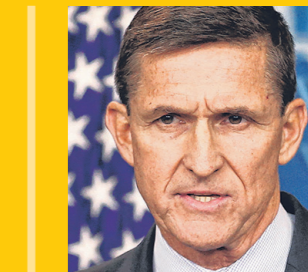
Major blow to Mr Trump as effort to scrap Obamacare is scuttled after three Republican senators break ranks. He later fires Mr Priebus, replacing him with retired general John Kelly.



## Who else has left since Mr Trump took office



**JANUARY**  
• Acting US Attorney-General Sally Yates gets the presidential boot after she orders Justice Department lawyers not to enforce his immigration ban.



**FEBRUARY**  
• National security adviser Michael Flynn resigns after revelations that he hid discussions on US sanctions on Russia with the Russian ambassador.



**MAY**  
• FBI director James Comey (left), who was investigating possible collusion with Russia over election results, is fired.  
• White House communications director Michael Dubke (right) resigns.



**JULY**  
• White House press secretary Sean Spicer (left) resigns as Mr Scaramucci takes over.
