Johor Baru-Singapore Rapid Transit System (RTS)

The Sultan of Johor has proposed that the planned elevated RTS link be lowered and realigned.
The train service is expected to begin by Dec 31, 2024.

- There will be two stations:
 - Woodlands North station on the Thomson-East Coast Line
 Debit Characteristics in Librar Barrards and IR Coast Line
- Bukit Chagar station in Johor Baru, close to JB Sentral train station
 The 4km track will cross the Johor Strait on a 25m-high bridge.
- It can carry up to 10,000 passengers in each direction, per hour.
- Customs and immigration facilities for both countries will be co-located
 that both stations.

 This means commuters leaving Singapore clear immigration checks for both countries at Woodlands North station.
 - Commuters leaving Malaysia clear immigration checks for both countries at Bukit Chagar station
