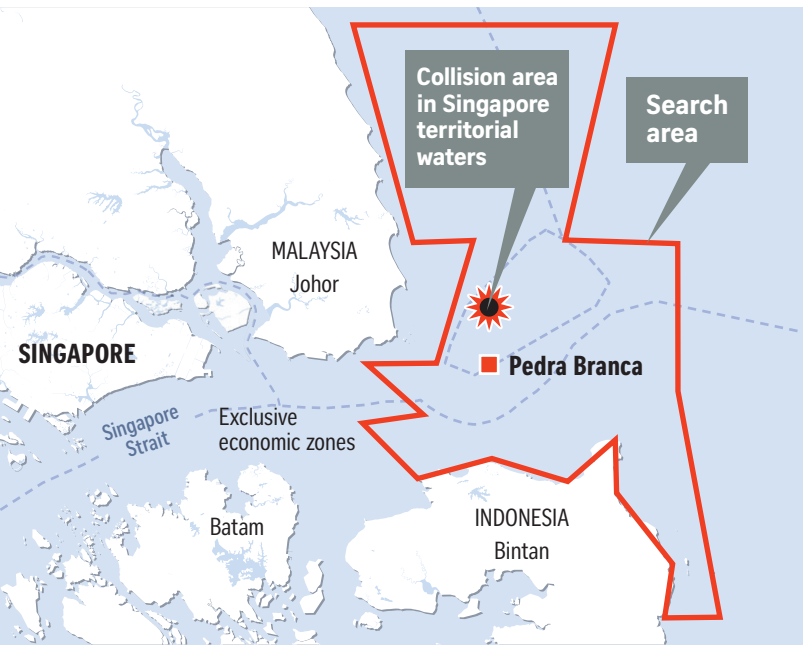


Search and rescue mission

The USS John S. McCain, a guided-missile destroyer, collided with the Alnic MC oil tanker in the Singapore Strait on Monday. No oil spill was reported but a search was under way for missing sailors.
