Key battles

Victor Moses v Sead Kolasinac

The two scorers in the Community Shield, although Moses' history against Arsenal also includes an FA Cup final red card for diving. While Kolasinac, who struck again on Thursday in the Europa League, has benefited from the sale of Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain to Liverpool, Moses faces competition from new signing Davide Zappacosta, a scorer on Tuesday in the Champions League.



David Luiz v Alexandre Lacazette

Lacazette has scored in both home games but his fortunes have been different on the road. The Frenchman had a goal controversially chalked off at Stoke and was benched at Liverpool. His movement could test Luiz, who struggled against Alexis Sanchez last September when the Chilean starred as an orthodox striker in a 3-0 Arsenal home win.



Alvaro Morata v Laurent Koscielny

Morata may have unpleasant memories of Arsenal after missing a penalty in the Community Shield shoot-out. Koscielny, meanwhile, missed both Wembley meetings after a red card at the end of last season. He will have to be aware of the Spaniard's aerial ability: Morata's three league goals have all been headers, two from Cesar Azpilicueta's crosses.
