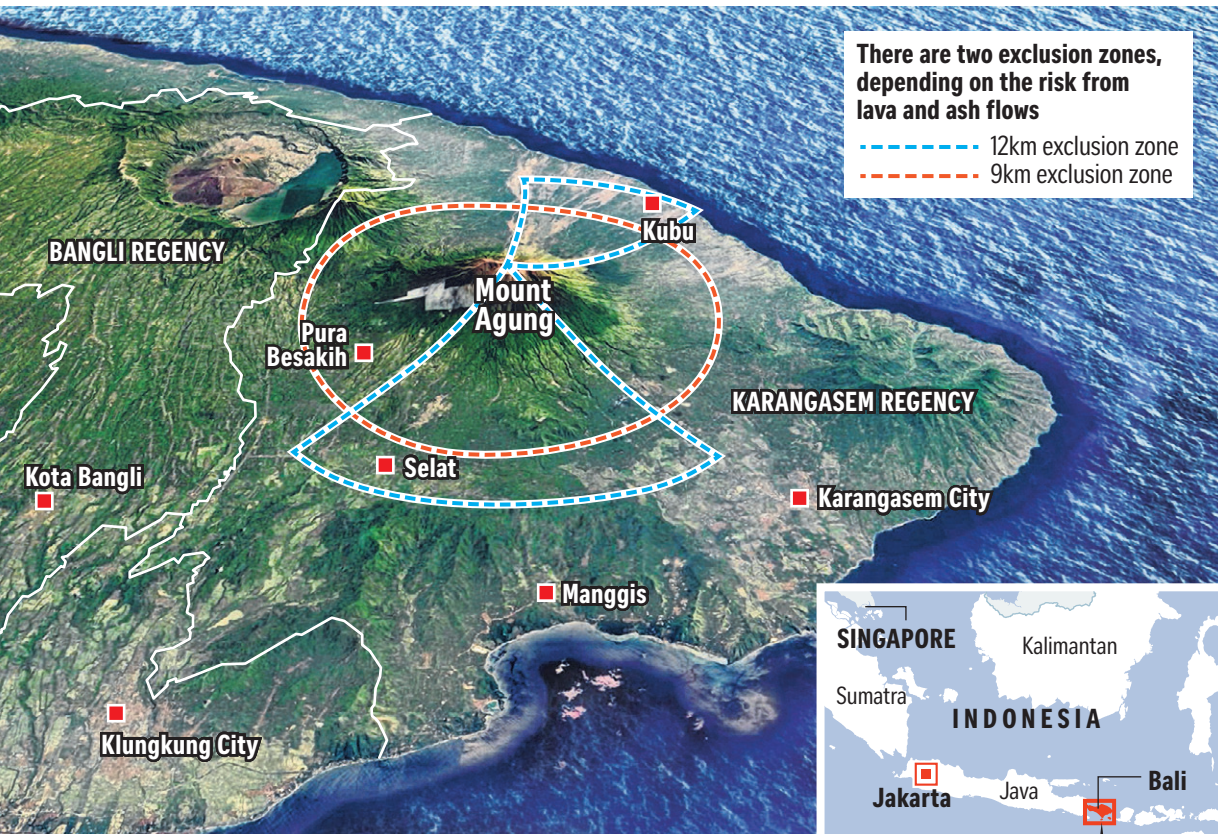


Thousands evacuated from danger

The authorities issue exclusion zones around Mount Agung as number of tremors grows.



- About 62,000 people live in the danger zone and they must move to evacuation centres.
- Thousands of cattle must also be evacuated.
- Tourist spots such as Besakih temple have been closed.
- BNPB officers are still combing the danger zones and appealing to residents to leave, some of whom do not want to be evacuated.
