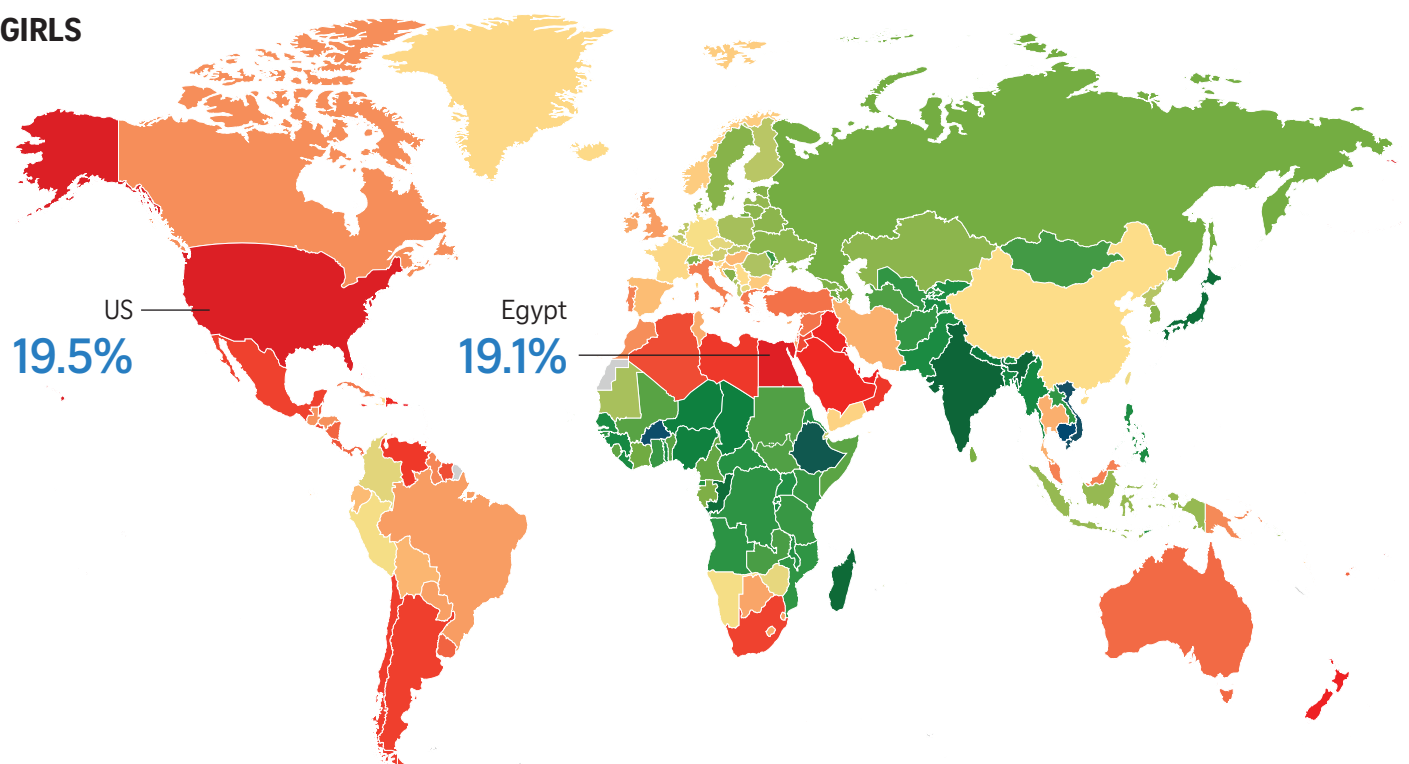


Obesity prevalence

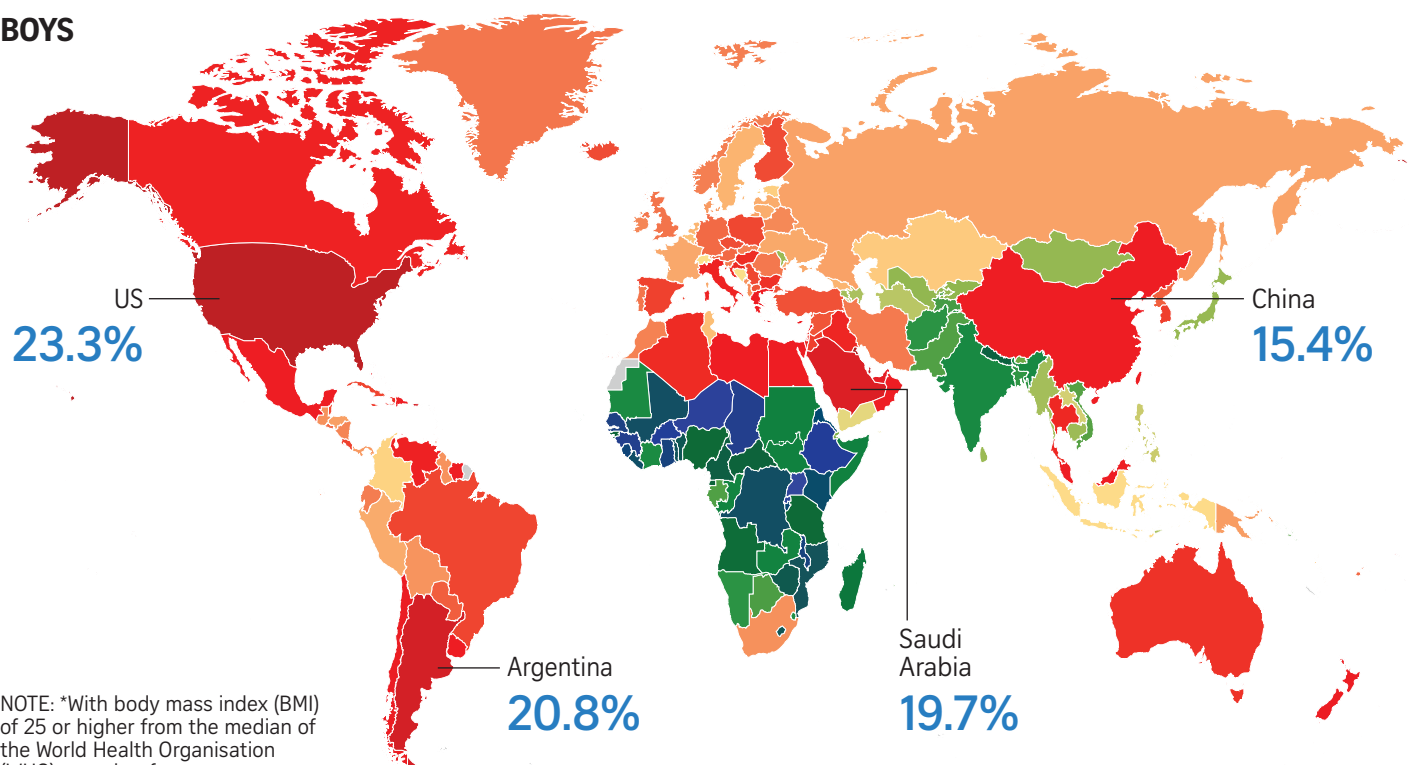
