

What's brewing in Jurong Lake District

New Science Centre

Part of many Singaporeans' childhood, the Science Centre will move from its Jurong Town Hall site to be the "jewel" of Jurong Lake Gardens in 2020. The old Science Centre is expected to be kept for other uses.

Seamless connections for commuters

Commuters should be able to access the HSR terminus and MRT stations easily, as well as be connected to other integrated pedestrian walkways like J-Walk, an existing sheltered linkway that bridges public institutions like Ng Teng Fong General Hospital and malls.

Jurong Lake Gardens

The third "Botanic Gardens" and the first large-scale national garden in the heartland, the 90ha site is meant to be a green lung where people can relax and take part in leisure activities.

A new island and waterway

The authorities will create a third island in Jurong Lake, as well as a new waterway around the lake, opening up more waterfront space for commercial and recreational activities.

New Central Park

Above the terminus will be a 10ha central park, featuring open spaces and water features.



High Speed Rail terminus

The station will be the end point for a fast-speed train that will connect Singapore to Kuala Lumpur in 90 minutes, compared with five hours by coach currently. It is expected to be ready in 2026.
