His acclaimed graphic novel The Art Of Charlie Chan Hock Chye, which examines Singapore's political history through the eyes of fictional artist Charlie Chan. scooped up three awards at the Will Fisner Comic Industry Awards – making him the first Singaporean to win the coveted accolade.



Wong Kah Chun

After coming out tops in the prestigious Gustav Mahler Conducting Competition, he has conducted leading orchestras around the world and will be the first Asian to take up the baton of chief conductor of Germany's Nuremberg Symphony Orchestra in September 2018.



Kirsten Tan

The award-winning film-maker's debut feature Pop Ave. a road movie about a disillusioned Thai architect and his elephant friend, has been picked as Singapore's submission to the 90th Academy Awards in the Foreign Language Film category.



Kvra Poh

The 15-year-old won the freestyle junior title at the biennial FAI World Indoor Skydiving Championship in October 2017, cementing her reputation as one of the top young talents in the sport. She also won gold at the Wind Games in Spain and the Australian Indoor Skydiving Championships earlier this year.

The co-founder and chief executive of Kapap Academy has made it her mission to save lives by equipping people with practical self-defence skills. Her efforts saw her receive the Queen's Young Leaders Award 2017, one of only 60 young people from the Commonwealth to do so.
