

Been there, going to do it?

All bets are off on Manchester City winning the Premier League title. Instead the focus now is on how early and how many records they are going to break.

PROJECTED RECORDS

Earliest title win Apr 14

Everton (a) **March 31**

or Man United (h), if results go their way **April 7**

• Record holders: Man United (2000-01), with five matches to spare

Most points in a season 95

GAP: 17 MAX: 105

Earliest to break: **April 22** Swansea (h)

Earliest to break 100: **May 5** Huddersfield (h)

• Record holders: Chelsea in 2004-05
• City, on 78 points with nine games to go, will finish with 105 points if they win all their remaining matches.

Biggest winning margin 18

May 13 • Record holders: Man United (1999-2000, ahead of Arsenal)
• City are 18 points clear of Liverpool, 16 if United beat Crystal Palace this morning (Singapore time).

Most wins in a season 30

GAP: 5 MAX: 34

Earliest to break: **April 22** Swansea (h)

• Record holders: Chelsea in 2016-17
• City on 25 wins and need six more out of nine to break the record.

Most away wins in a season 15

GAP: 4 MAX: 16

May 13 Southampton (a)

• Record holders: Chelsea in 2004-05
• City have won 11 out of 14 with five more to play, meaning they could break it on the last day of the season.

Most goals in a season 103

GAP: 20 PROJECTED: 111

May 13 Southampton (a)

• Record holders: Chelsea in 2009-10
• City are on 83 goals, averaging 2.9 goals a game. At this rate, they could finish with 111.

Most home goals in a season 68

GAP: 17 PROJECTED: 64

May 5 Huddersfield (h)

• Record holders: Chelsea in 2009-10
• City are on 51 goals with four more games

Best goal difference +71

GAP: 8 PROJECTED: +84

May 13 Southampton (a)

• Record holders: Chelsea in 2009-10
• City have conceded an average of 0.69 goals (20 in 29), meaning that they could let in another seven goals for a total of 27 goals. Assuming 111 scored, GD +84.

RECORDS BROKEN

Most consecutive wins 18

Dec 27 1-0 v Newcastle

• Previous record: 13 Arsenal (2001-02) and Chelsea (2016-17)

Best start after 10 games

Nov 5 2017 9W, 1D, 28 points, goal difference of +29

• Previous record: Man City (2011-12) 28 points GD +28
