Indonesia's population, some 200 million of whom are eligible to vote. More than 133 million votes were cast at the last general election in 2014.

160 million

The number of voters in 171 regions who can elect local leaders in 17 provinces, 39 cities and 115 regencies on June 27.

This is the biggest single-day election to be held in Indonesia.

Number of MPs in the People's Representative Council today. This will increase to 575 in 2019 due to changes in the electoral map. A party, or coalition of parties, must win 288 seats for a parliamentary majority next year.

Number of Indonesian presidents since independence in 1945.

Number of political parties eligible to contest the 2019 general election. These include four new parties taking part in the polls for the first time.

Number of direct presidential elections. The first, in 2004, was won by Dr Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono, who was reelected in 2009. His predecessors were elected by Parliament.
