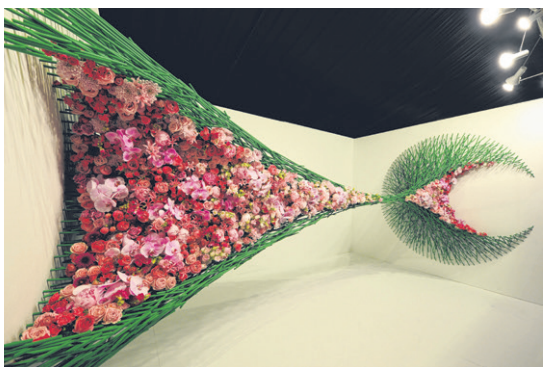


Festival attractions

1. Orchid Extravaganza

This segment at the Flower Dome will showcase the world's largest family of flowering plants. Award-winning Singaporean filmmaker Royston Tan
