## Fake news campaigns can proliferate through tech tools: Cyber security expert

For just US\$1 (S\$1.31), fake news operators can buy "likes" or "dislikes" to ratchet up the popularity of fake news stories, or start a campaign against content that they disagree with.

And by harnessing other underground tools and abusing legitimate services, such operators regiminate services, such operators can even manipulate public opinion to the extent that it could provoke a protest – all for a sum of US\$200,000. This could, for example, be done here to instigate a protest against Budget announcements that could affect households such as the

could affect households, such as the impending increase in goods and services tax, if the content panders to its audience's beliefs, says a cyber security expert. In her written submission, Ms Myla

Pilao, director of core technology

marketing at cyber security company Trend Micro, based in Tokyo, painted this hypothetical scenario to illustrate how fake news campaigns can proliferate through technological tools and services, and have a real-life impact. While legislation could be one of the counter-measures, technology

and education can also help address the issue of fake news, Ms Pilao told Workers' Party MP Pritam Singh, one of the committee members. yesterday. For example, organisations in the

information and communications technology sector, like social media companies, can work together to analyse and monitor fake news. There should also be a centralised

body that can help users validate content, she added.
