The Land Transport Authority implements safety measures at accident-prone junctions such as turning pockets, guiding lines and pedestrian countdown timers.



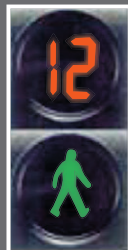
Red-amber-green arrows to be introduced at as many right-turning junctions as possible

Give Way to Pedestrians sign

Guide right-turning vehicles and prevent them from getting into the path of on-coming traffic

Broken white lines to guide motorists across junctions
