Five blasts in two days

Indonesia has seen suicide-bomber families carry out a series of attacks that have left more than 20 people dead.

SURABAYA

- Family of six stages suicide attacks on three churches, killing themselves in the act
- 12 people killed, 44 injured. It was the first suicide bombing by a family in Indonesia.



The suicide-bomber family

Father: Dita Oepriarto, 46

- Occupation: Merchant
- Drove a car containing explosives and rammed it into the gate of the Surabaya Centre Pentecostal Church.

Mother: Puii Kuswati. 42

Occupation: Company employee


Daughters: Fadhila Sari, 12, and Famela Rizqita, nine


- The mother and her daughters carried out the attack at the GKI Diponegoro Church.
- Wearing niqab face veils and with bombs strapped to their waists, they entered the grounds of the church and blew themselves up.

Sons: Yusuf Fadhil, 17, and Firman Halim, 15

- The two, both elementary school drop outs, carried out the Santa Maria Church bombing.
- They were on a motorcycle and carried the explosives "across their laps", said police.
