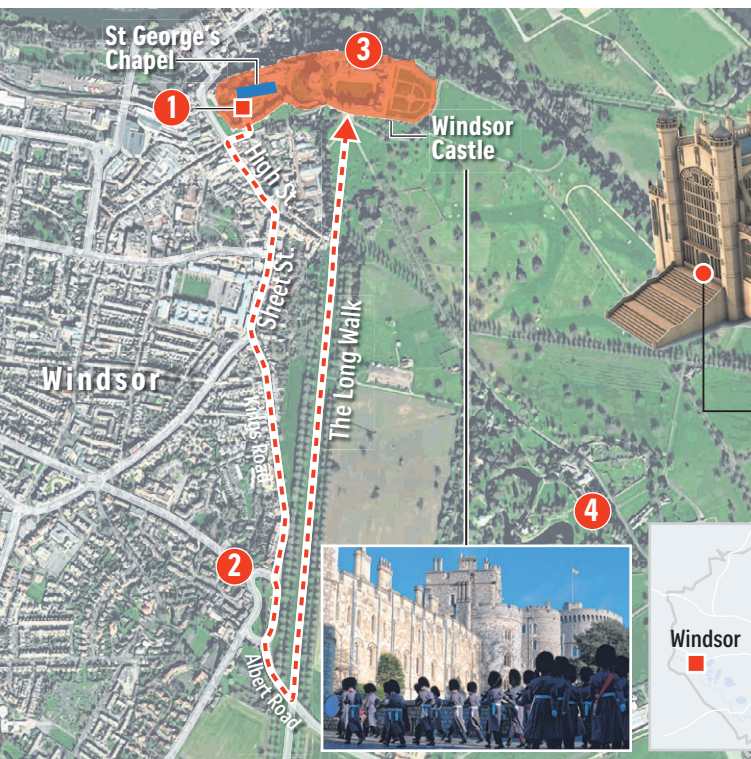
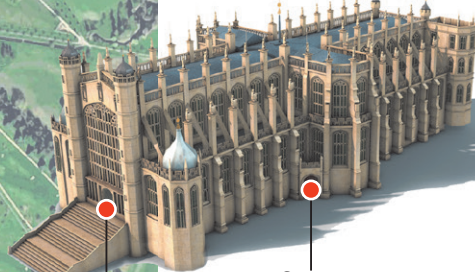

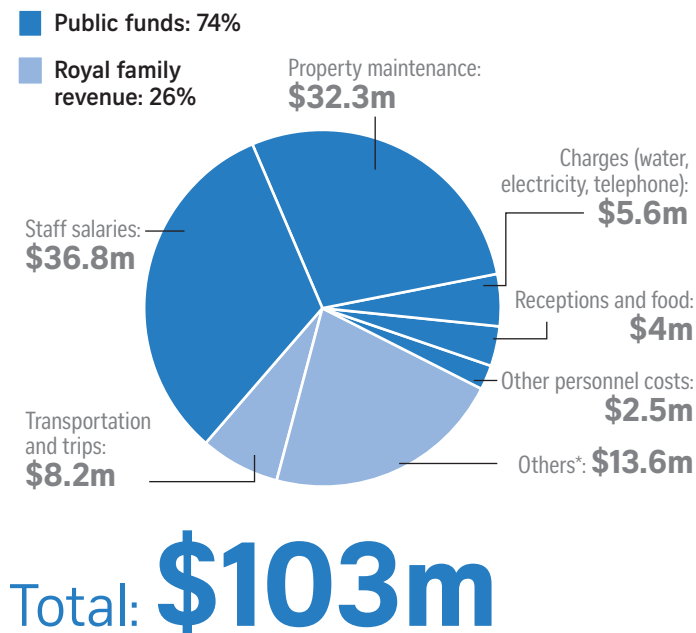


EVENTS AND TIMING

- 1 Noon (local time), church service**
600 guests will arrive from 9.30 to 11am and walk to St George's Chapel, the ceremony begins at midday.
- 2 1pm, Carriage procession**
After the ceremony, the couple will leave Windsor Castle. Soldiers from The Life Guards of the Household Cavalry Mounted Regiment (right) are part of the mounted travelling escort.
- 3 1.30pm, St. George's Hall**
The couple will join a lunchtime reception at St George's Hall at Windsor Castle, which will be given by Queen Elizabeth.
- 4 Evening, Frogmore House**
Later in the evening, 200 guests will attend a private reception which will be hosted by Harry's father, Charles, the Prince of Wales.
