

# Malaysia's Cabinet line-up

Malaysia's new Pakatan Harapan administration saw 13 of its Cabinet ministers sworn in at the palace yesterday. The team, helmed by Prime Minister Mahathir Mohamad, was drawn from the coalition's four member parties – Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR), the Democratic Action Party (DAP), Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia (PPBM) and Parti Amanah Negara (Amanah).



**Prime Minister**  
**Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, 92**

- Pakatan Harapan chairman
- PPBM chairman and MP for Langkawi, Kedah
- Was PM from 1981 to 2003



**Deputy Prime Minister**  
**Minister for Women and Family Development**  
**Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail, 65**

- PKR president and MP for Pandan, Selangor
- Has been an MP since 1999



**Housing and Local Government Minister**  
**Datuk Zuraida Kamaruddin, 60**

- PKR MP for Ampang, Selangor
- She is PKR Women's chief and has been an MP since 2008



**Transport Minister**  
**Mr Anthony Loke, 41**

- DAP organising secretary and MP for Seremban, Negri Sembilan
- He has been an MP since 2008



**Communications and Multimedia Minister**  
**Gobind Singh Deo, 44**

- DAP national legal bureau secretary and MP for Puchong, Selangor
- The lawyer has been an MP since 2008



**Home Affairs Minister**  
**Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, 71**

- PPBM president and MP for Pagoh, Johor
- Was Deputy PM from 2009 to 2015



**Finance Minister**  
**Mr Lim Guan Eng, 57**

- DAP secretary-general and MP for Baglan, Penang
- Was Penang Chief Minister from 2008 to 2015



**Defence Minister**  
**Mr Mohamad Sabu, 63**

- Amanah president and MP for Kota Raja, Selangor
- Was PAS deputy president from 2011 to 2015



**Education Minister**  
**Dr Maszlee Malik, 43**

- PPBM MP for Simpang Renggam, Johor
- The academic was a visiting fellow at Singapore's ISEAS – Yusof Ishak Institute in 2016



**Rural Development Minister**  
**Ms Rina Harun, 44**

- PPBM MP for Titiwangsa, Kuala Lumpur
- She used to work in finance and is PPBM Women's chief



**Economic Affairs Minister**  
**Datuk Seri Azmin Ali, 53**

- PKR deputy president and MP for Gombak, Selangor
- He has been Selangor Menteri Besar since 2014



**Human Resources Minister**  
**M. Kulasegaran, 61**

- DAP national vice-chairman and MP for Ipoh Barat, Perak
- The lawyer was first elected MP in a 1997 by-election



**Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Minister**  
**Mr Salahuddin Ayub, 56**

- Amanah deputy president and MP for Pulau, Johor
- The former PAS vice-president was first elected an MP in 2004



**Health Minister**  
**Dr Dzulkefly Ahmad, 62**

- Amanah strategic director and MP for Kuala Selangor
- The former academic has a doctorate in toxicology from London's Imperial College
