

What's new on Ubin?



Arrow emperor dragonfly

- Has a distinct T-mark on the front and an elongated third abdominal segment
- Observed by NParks staff on Pulau Ubin last October



Long-winged tomb bat

- The insectivorous bat has wings that are long and narrow
- Identified during a field survey at Chek Jawa last December



Little stint shorebird

- Breeds in the Arctic and migrates south in August and September to escape the harsh winter
- Identified following a survey of shorebirds at the Chek Jawa Wetlands last September



Raccoon pseudo-orb weaver spider

- A long-legged, medium-sized spider with patterns reminding one of a raccoon's tail
- Specimens were collected on Pulau Ubin last year



Big-eared pipistrelle

- The insectivorous bat has large, broad ears, and whitish, translucent wings
- Identified during a field survey at Chek Jawa last December
