- Offering sandbags to some 600 residents and businesses in low-lying, flood-prone areas upon request and issuing advisories with tips on protecting belongings and premises from floodwaters.



- Carrying out 24/7 online flood monitoring and having a Quick Response Team on standby during the monsoon season to check drains for chokes and render assistance during flash floods.



- Working with building developers to implement measures that slow down runoff from development sites into the public drainage system, such as on-site detention tanks and rain gardens.



- Stepping up checks on the drainage systems at critical installations and construction sites around Singapore to ensure they are unobstructed and can convey stormwater during heavy rain.



- Collaborating with the Automobile Association of Singapore to provide its members with safety tips on navigating flash floods.



- Drainage projects and improvement works that reduce flood risks and enhance flood protection in areas such as Orchard Road and Bukit Timah.
