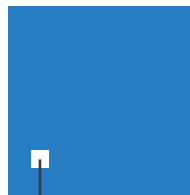

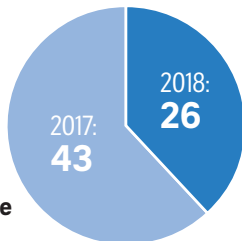

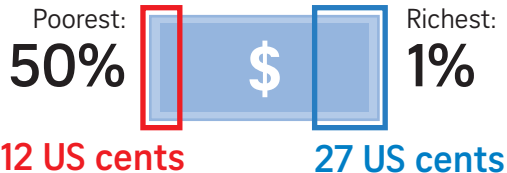
The health budget of Ethiopia:
