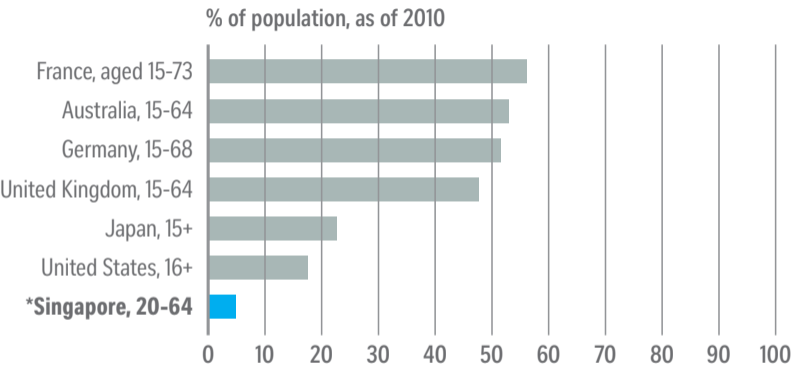


# Persons with disabilities who are employed



NOTE: \*Singapore's rate of 4.88% is calculated based on 8,600 persons with disabilities (PWDs) employed in the public and private sectors in 2017, out of a population of 175,973 PWDs who were aged 20 to 64 years old in 2017, tabulated according to MSF's estimates of the prevalence of disability among different age cohorts in the resident population.
