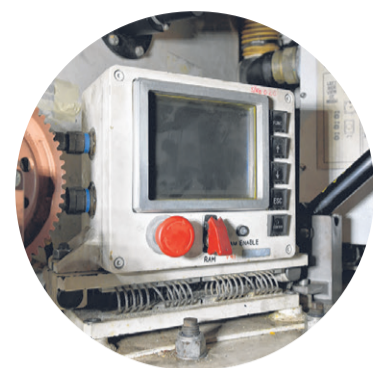


# Safety measures in the howitzer's cabin

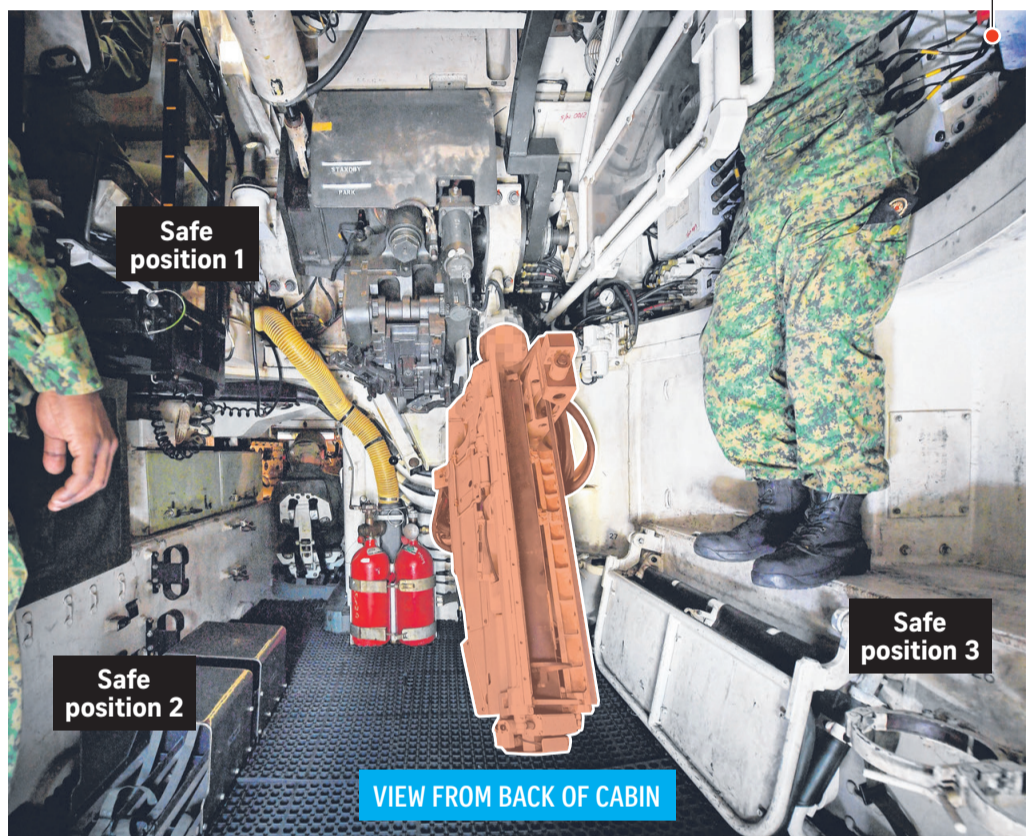
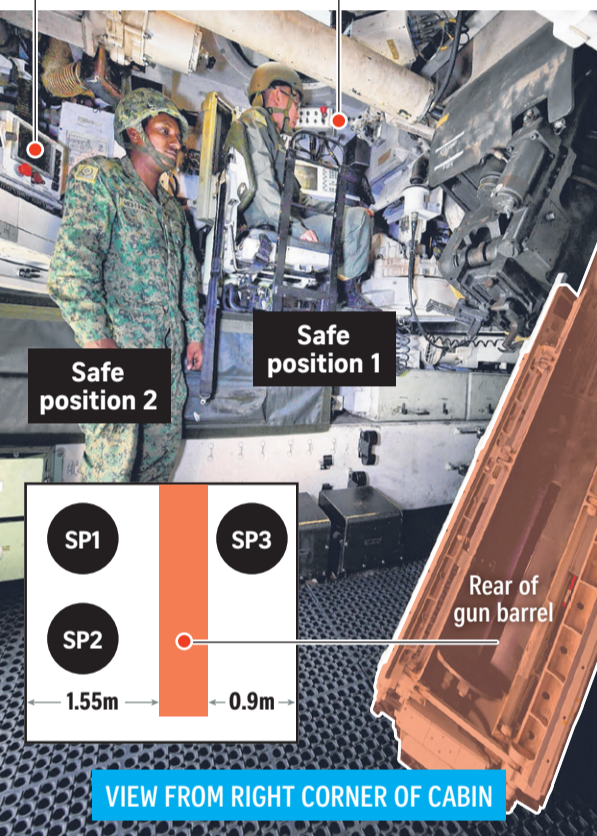
The two other servicemen in the cabin of the Singapore Self-Propelled Howitzer (SSPH) with Corporal First Class (NS) Aloysius Pang were experienced in SSPH maintenance, said Defence Minister Ng Eng Hen in Parliament yesterday. He also outlined the safety features of the SSPH and said it has been inspected for any malfunction of the gun barrel's lowering mechanism.

## INSIDE THE HOWITZER'S CABIN



### Buttons

The gun commander, charge loader or ammo loader can activate an emergency stop button located within reach of their respective operating positions. This is for emergency situations that require the gun barrel or other mechanical moving parts in the turret to immediately cease movement.



### Main cabin

The cabin is divided into two by the rear end of the gun barrel. "Safe" positions are located on either sides of the gun barrel. Such safety procedures are taught to all maintenance and SSPH operating crew.
